(AFI)** thru its member company – **Cotabato Light and Power Company (CLPC)** had once again donated a colorful 1 storey - 2 classrooms kindergarten building worth about 1.4 Million. This time the beneficiary-recipient was Notre Dame Village Central Elementary School (NDVCES).

The ceremonial turnover was done on September 18, 2013 wherein NDVCES formally received the building complete with textbooks, furniture and fixtures. Also, five of NDVCES teachers were sent to a free training held at Malagos, Davao City sometime in May this year.
